



FASA Scholarship Program

In an effort to help deserving players who may not otherwise be able to afford the expense of select soccer, FASA establishes this Scholarship Program. This program is intended to provide financial assistance to qualified players. Qualification takes into consideration financial needs as well as other factors that may influence a player's ability to pay club fees.

Parents/Guardians of scholarship applicants should meet the requirements outlined in this program. Parents/Guardians whose income exceeds the Income Eligibility Guidelines may request financial assistance. The FASA Board of Directors, on a case basis, will address these individual hardship requests.

There are three levels of financial assistance available. The total scholarship value is \$125 and will help cover per player fees only.

- A) *Full Scholarship 100%*,
- B) *Partial Scholarship 75%*
- C) *Partial Scholarship 50%*,

The Parent/Guardian will be responsible for remaining per player fees, tournament fees, uniform and other player expenses. You will also be expected to participate in club and team fundraisers .

I understand that playing on a FASA team will be a significant commitment on my part and on my child's part. By submitting this Financial Assistance Application, I agree that my player(s) will regularly attend team practices, games, and tournaments. I further agree to volunteer time to help support the club as indicated above.

Applications for scholarships are available in both the fall and spring seasons. Applications forms are available on the FASA website (www.hotspurs.org) or the FASA Office and must be sent to Kari Blosser, FASA Treasurer. If my child(ren) leaves the club prior to the end of the season, I agree to immediately repay FASA the full amount of any scholarship monies that I may receive through the club as a result of submitting this Financial Assistance Application.

All applications will be handled in a confidential manner. The Scholarship Committee, approved by the Board of Directors, will review all scholarship applications. Parents/Guardians will receive notification of the Committee's decision.

Directions for Scholarship Application

- 1) Parent/Guardian obtains application from FASA website or FASA Office.
- 2) Board reviews applications and notifies Parent/Guardian of decision.
- 3) FASA Treasurer makes adjustments, if any, to players account.
