

Fredericksburg Area Soccer Association (FASA) Hotspurs Meeting

Minutes for the September 18, 2006 club meeting. The meeting was held at Cosner Park Community Center, Fredericksburg, Virginia.

President – Wayne Zimmerman

The meeting was brought to order by Mr. Zimmerman at 7:107pm.

The following announcements were made by Mr. Zimmerman:

- KidSafe documentation has been entered, reviewed and approved.

Director of Coaching/Program Director – Pete Cinalli

Mr. Cinalli and Mr. Van Reenen made the following announcements:

- The creation of the Hotspur Park Soccer Complex in Spotsylvania County is meeting with resistance from the local home owners.
- Mr. Cinalli and Mr. Van Reenen requested a meeting with the homeowners to discuss the complex and answer any questions. They were officially refused.
- A meeting has been scheduled with a local lawyer this week to discuss whether the development of the land would be considered “special use permit”
- Special use permit would require numerous public meetings and massive team and community support.
- Land is currently zoned A3.
- The cost of the project is estimated at 1.5 million.
- Project will need funding from local business and partners.

Mr. Cinalli made the following announcements:

- The same “Per Team” model will be used as in previous years for fees.
 - Current model is operation fee plus league fee. The total of both is what the team owes. The team then divides the cost by the number of players on their roster.
 - Motion was made by Mr. Jon Skavdahl and 2nd by Ms. Ann Hopwood that on this date the club would implement the above “Per team” model.
- New payment schedule for fees:
 - :League fees are due December 1, 2006
 - Balance due February 2007.
