Coaching Education

Elite Soccer Camp

- Elite Soccer Camp very successful – pictures on website. This will continue to be a staple high-level training camp that we offer every summer.

Field of Dreams Update:

- Met with Tricord and VYSA last week. Next step is to make a formal presentation to the County for help with running water/sewer and also some other concessions. VYSA is 100% committed and ready. We have preliminary bank approval and are working on a letter from the bank to provide as part of the presentation to the County Board. Once this gets to the next level – it will move much faster. Pete has an updated plan available to show anyone that may be interested.

ASDL Coaching Session

- Pete will be running the ASDL coaches training session on Monday 8/25 at the Fieldhouse. Also – I'm working with Melissa to come up with a bi-weekly ASDL training program that will be every other Friday at Hotspur Park – and am looking for other FASA coaches that would like to be involved in the program. We will be running training sessions for the ASDL players to help develop the players, coaches and program. This will be another huge benefit that will set this program apart.

New FASA Office:

- New office at the Fieldhouse. The plan is for our office to be ready around October 1st. More news to follow.

New Uniform Order Form

- Pete made a new uniform order form / spreadsheet that is on the website to simplify the ordering process. Also have ordered new coaches jerseys for all coaches – waiting on Billy to deliver them – should be any time! All FASA coaches will get them.. I asked for them to be ready for the FASA tournament.

Other Notes:

- Dutch Coach: Dates will most likely be moved back to October. More news to follow. Great Responses from teams
- Pete has attended several team/parent meetings over the past month and is available to meet with any others upon request (for any reason)
- Reminder that if any teams want to schedule a college prep meeting – let Pete know.
- Look for a detailed posting on the following new policies in the near future:
 - Coaches Pay Dates (coaches will be paid in 2 installments – halfway through the season – and after the season ends)
 - Coaches travel reimbursement policy. Highlights: Each head coach is eligible for up to \$250 travel reimbursement per season. Recommendation is that the team pays for coaches travel as they have in the past – save all receipts – and turn them in when they hit the \$250 threshold – or at the end of the season if they do not. Reimbursement for travel is once per season (cannot ask for multiple checks) – and must be accompanied by receipts to be reimbursed. Each team will cover travel that exceeds the \$250.
 - Patches (each team has a patch allowance)
 - Tournament Allowance (each team has a tournament allowance)
 - The procedure will be detailed and sent via email to all managers/coaches – and will be posted on the FASA website for easy access 24/7.
